It's time to dust off your quills and crack the binding on your thesaurus to write an original sonnet for the Riverside Theatre Shakespeare Festival.

Three cash prizes will be awarded!

“Can I enter?”

- If you are in grades 9 –12 you sure can!
- If you are in grades 7 –8 you can enter the *What You WILL* Poetry Contest.

“Cheers!” I can enter! But now what?”

1. Pick a topic and write a sonnet. Simply stated, a sonnet is a 14-line lyric poem. Alas, it is a little more complicated than that, but you can check our website for writing tips or ask your teacher for help.
2. Your submitted sonnet must be typewritten on one side of an 8 ½” x 11” sheet of paper. **Do not** put your name on the sonnet.
3. **On the back** of your sonnet, put your initials followed by your birth date. By doing this you are assured anonymity when the judges look at your work. An example is: A.F.W. 6/14/94.
4. Next, fill out the Official Entry & Release Form. It is especially important to have your teacher sign the form to certify that your sonnet is original. Any evidence of plagiarism will disqualify the entry.
5. Final step! Deliver your sonnet and Official Entry and Release Form by **March 1, 2011** to:
